COSTS BY ACTIVITY

What are the rates applied by the cultural entities, the Regional Direction of Cultural Affairs in your territory?

Remember to add social charges to the gross hourly rate. (e.g.: 60€/h + 30€ social charges=90€/h).

Don't forget to add the VAT cost if it is applicable (rate before and after value added tax).



- by train : based on the SNCF 2nd class rates on the dates in question.
- by car : on the basis of the applicable mileage allowance/rate.



Where will the artist be accommodated? (hotel, apartment, etc...).

Some collective agreements impose a scale (e.g.: a rate of 18.80€ per meal, for the Syndeac, Union of Artistic and Cultural Enterprises).

Consider school cafeteria fees; lunch boxes can also reduce costs. (e.g.: I5€/day).



If you have to pay for tickets, ask theatres for group rates, as they are cheaper than single tickets.
